**RE: Camps for Children**

### **Handicamp Lutheran Hills Camp, Helmsburg, IN-317-846-4026**

Ages 10 to adult. Four days in June. Co-ed residential camp for children and adults who are developmentally disabled, or mild to moderately mentally handicapped. Swimming, nature walks, crafts, singing, Bible stories. Scholarships available on a case by case basis. The application deadline is three weeks prior to the start of camp. There is also a registration fee; contact the camp for the amount. **Campers must be ambulatory and toilet trained.**

### **Happiness Bag, Terre Haute, IN- 812-234-8867**

Ages 5 to adult. Residential and day camp for all disabilities. Residential camp is one week in August. Nine week day camp. Day camp is from June 5 through August 2. Music, swimming, arts and crafts, drama, nature, recreational activities. A limited amount of scholarships are available. Application deadline is May 25 or until camp is full. A registration for residential camp is required at the time of application (half of the total camp fee). Cannot take children needing medical attention such as catheters, trachs, insulin shots, etc.

### **Indian Creek Baptist Camp, R.R. 12 Box 980, Bedford, IN-812-279-2161**

Ages 10 to adult. One week in June and one week in July. Co-ed residential camp for children and adults who are mildly and moderately mentally handicapped, physically disabled, or learning disabled. Music, swimming, fishing, arts and crafts, hikes, skit night, talent program. No scholarships available. **Children and adults must have self-help skills and must be toilet trained.**

### **Camp Isanogel 7601 West Isanogel Road, 50 North, Muncie, IN 317-288-1073**

Ages 8-15. Several camps available in June, July, and August. Co-ed residential camp for mentally and physically disabled children. Arts and crafts, swimming, fishing, sleep outs, music, drama, wheelchair sports, cookouts. Scholarships are available. Fees must be paid two weeks before camp, applications are accepted on a first come, first serve basis. There are weeks available for children who are physically disabled and other weeks for children who are mentally disabled. However, mentally disabled children are included in all sessions when available.

### **Jameson Camp, 2001 South Bridgeport Road, Indianapolis, IN 317-923-3925**

Ages 7-12 for regular sessions, ages 7-14 for weight loss program. Three 12-day sessions throughout the summer for regular camp. Two sessions in June and August for weight loss program. Co-ed residential camp for children with emotional and social needs, nutritional problems, and minor physical disabilities. Archery, soccer, swimming, arts and crafts, camping, singing, cookouts, team games. Scholarships are available on a case by case basis. Individual interviews are conducted. Children must be self-sufficient.

**Kiwanis Twin Lakes Camp for Crippled Children, Twin Lakes, Plymouth, IN- 312-767-3017 or 708-687-0771**

Ages 7-26. Three 18-day sessions starting in the middle of June and grouped by ages: 7-12, 13-17, and 18-26. Co-ed residential camp for the physically disabled. Swimming, fishing, boating, varied sports, arts and crafts, games, short excursions, nightly entertainment. Scholarships are available on a case by case basis. Applications are taken until camp is filled and then put on a waiting list. There is no registration fee. They take no children on breathing apparatus.

**Camp Koch, Troy, IN 812-547-5581**

Ages 8 and above. Several weeks over the summer. Co-ed residential camp for primarily physically disabled children, although they take other disabilities. (Check with camp.) Swimming, nature and environmental activities, creative art, camp craft, dances, carnivals, and adventure challenge programs. Scholarships are available on a case by case basis. Will take applications till camp is full. There is no registration fee. Cannot handle severe profound mentally handicapped children.

**Camp KYOC, 1902 Easterly Road, Carrollton, KY 41008 – 502-732-5333**

All ages. Camps for adults and children offering registered nurse, trained counselors, and program staff who are on site 24 hours. Swimming, boating, fishing, interacting with farm animals, campfires, etc. One week sessions starting in June.

**Camp Millhouse, 25600 Kelly Road, South Bend, IN- 219-233-2202**

Ages 7- adult. One-week sessions divided by ages from June through mid-August. Co-ed residential camp for the mentally and multiply disabled. Drama, music, crafts, swimming, nature study, hikes. A limited number of scholarships are available. No application deadline, however, applications are taken on a first come, first serve basis.

**Camp Potawotami, South Milford, IN- 219-351-2525**

Ages 8-14, teen adventure program ages 13-18. Six one-week programs available. Co-ed residential camp that mainstreams children with mild disabilities on a case by case basis. Archery, fishing, arts and crafts, campfire, group games, swimming, canoeing, sailing. Scholarships are available. Children are accepted until capacity is reached. **Children must be toilet trained.**

**Red Cedar Center, 3900 Hursh Road, Ft. Wayne, IN- 219-637-3608**

Ages 6-adult. Year-round camp program. Residential and day camps for all disabled populations. Therapeutic horseback riding, music therapy, arts and crafts, nature lore, and other camp activities. Prices vary depending on camp. Scholarships are available. Applications are taken until camp is full.

**Camp Riley, Bradford Woods, 5040 State Road 67 North, Martinsville, IN- 317-342-2915**

Ages 8-18. Three 12-day sessions to choose from in July and August. Co-ed residential camp for all physically disabled children. Swimming, camping, canoeing, crafts, games, archery, horseback riding. Scholarships are available.

**Salvation Army Camp, Bedford, IN- 812-279-2495**

Ages 7-adult, including the family. Sessions run all summer. Co-ed residential camp. Mainstream children with disabilities on a case by case basis. The camp has a behavior contract that the camper and parent must sign. Recreation, Bible, crafts, nature, elective sessions, swimming (including instruction). Free. Application deadline is two weeks before camp session.

**Camp Waycross, R.R. 2, Box 250, Morgantown, IN- 812-597-4241**

Ages 8-16. One week in July. Co-ed residential camp for children who are mild to moderately mentally handicapped. Arts and crafts, singing, hiking. Scholarships are available. Applications are taken until the camp is full. **Children must be ambulatory.**

**Wilderness Inquiry, Box 84, 1313 Fifth Street Southeast, Minneapolis, MN- 512-379-3858**

All ages, but if under 18, must be accompanied by a parent or adult. Trips with camping. Various trips for all abilities. Disabled and able bodied participate in integrated groups. Prices vary according to the trip.

**Camp Dellwood, 1800 Meridian, Indianapolis, IN 317-924-3450, Ext. 156**

Girls K-6 with disabilities. Nine consecutive sessions of day camp. Girls with disabilities are also encouraged to attend Girl Scout Day Camp. Crafts, hiking, swimming, and nature. Contact the Girl Scout office for detailed information.
